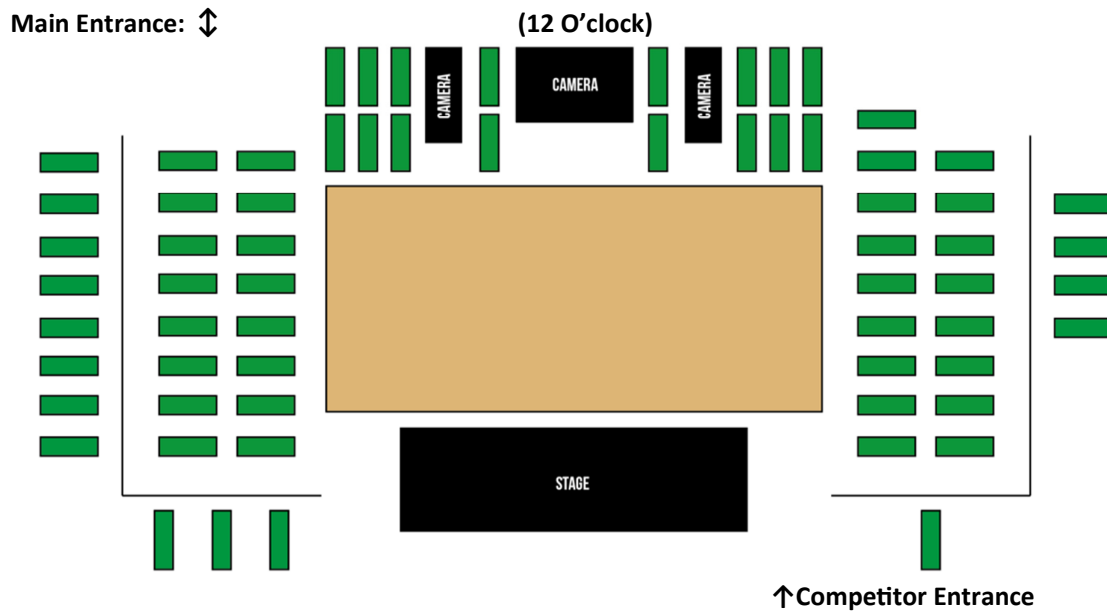

THE VENUE:

The Winter Gardens is a large entertainment complex located in Blackpool's town centre, about 250 metres from the sea front, Blackpool, Lancashire, England, which includes a theatre, ballroom and conference facilities.

The Winter Gardens opened in 1878, it is a Grade II* listed building and has hosted the Blackpool Dance Festival since its inception in 1920, and the World Matchplay darts tournament since 1994.

At World Dance Masters, we have full access to three of the Winter Gardens Ballrooms - The Empress Ballroom, The Spanish Hall, and The Arena.

HOW TO GET TO BLACKPOOL

By Air:

The closest airport to Blackpool is Manchester (MAN). You will then need to arrange transport from the airport by train to Blackpool.

By Train:

Blackpool is well-connected to the national railway network. There are direct services from London Euston and Manchester International Airport to Blackpool North Station.

ACCOMMODATION

Visitors to Blackpool are fortunate that whatever their budget, there is a quality establishment to suit every pocket.

We recommend when booking your accommodation for the event to use the visitblackpool.com website. All property advertised is nationally accredited by the AA, Visit England or VisitBritain, meaning that all the accommodation featured has been independently assessed against set criteria, so you are assured quality wherever you decide to book.

The Rainbow Line Dancers have used different hotels and guest houses in Blackpool. We need to be within walking distance of the Winter Gardens.

Once we know how many people will be joining us – suitable accommodation will be booked at a discounted group rate.

PASSPORT & VISA:

South African Passport holders DO require a visa for the UK! (± R1500)

A Schengen Visa is required if visiting Europe or Transiting through a European Airport.

PLEASE let me know as soon as possible if you would like to join the Rainbow Line Dancers in Blackpool for the annual WDM Championships!

Remember – you must qualify at one Regional Competition in South Africa to compete in the SA Masters Championships. Then you can attend the international competition and compete.

Best is to confirm your attendance and start paying for the Weekend Pass; Competitors Entry Fee, Airline ticket and train ticket over the next few months in order to spread the costs over a period of time and not sit with a huge bill when you need to apply for the UK Visa.
